### Day 1 – JUNE 29 (Sun.) – New York

Depart Mississippi the evening of June 28<sup>th</sup> for your journey to the “Big Apple. (1210 miles/20 +hours). Arrive in New York by late evening on the 29<sup>th</sup>. Your tour with Globus officially begins upon arrival at the hotel. *You will be responsible for meals on the road to New York (fast food type).*

### Day 2 – JUNE 30 (Mon.) – New York

Enjoy a morning of leisure in your hotel. This afternoon, head to **Planet Hollywood** for lunch. Take a walk for six blocks up to **TOP OF THE ROCK** for a bird’s eye view of the city. Enjoy some free time for window shopping on 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue, visiting NBC Studios, or venturing into **Times Square**. This evening, the great views of Manhattan continue aboard the ZEPHYR on your dinner and DJ dance cruise!

### Day 3 – JULY 1(Tues.) – New York

This morning enjoy a Ferry to the **STATUE OF LIBERTY** (performance pending approval) and the Ellis Island **IMMIGRATION MUSEUM**, telling the story of the 12 million immigrants who passed through New York. Enjoy lunch at South Street Seaport via voucher before continuing your tour of lower Manhattan including Greenwich Village, Wall Street, Ground Zero, and St. Paul’s Chapel, the church for all the relief workers after 9/11. Enjoy dinner tonight at **HARD ROCK CAFÉ** before enjoying a **BROADWAY SHOW** (*Mary Poppins*).

### Day 4 – JULY 2 (Wed.) – New York-Washington,

DC This morning head to Washington, D.C. Upon arrival visit the **NATIONAL ARCHIVES** to see the **Constitution and Declaration of Independence**. Enjoy a hearty buffet dinner at Harriett’s Family Restaurant before heading to your hotel for check-in. Tonight experience an **EVENING ILLUMINATION TOUR** including the **Vietnam Veterans, Korean**

**War and Lincoln Memorials, and Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts.**

**Day 5 – JULY 3(Thurs.) – Washington, D.C.** This morning visit **ARLINGTON NATIONAL CEMETERY** (possible wreath laying ceremony pending approval) to visit the **Tomb of the Unknown Soldier** and the **Kennedy Gravesites**. This afternoon, head to **Pentagon City Mall** for a brief rest and lunch stop before (Concert performance at **World War II Memorial**) Our tour continues as we travel to **Mount Vernon** the restored home of George Washington and visit the first President’s gravesite. This evening enjoy dinner at your hotel followed by our **HYPE MEETING!**

### Day 6 – JULY 4 (Fri.) – Washington, D.C.

This morning depart for your performance in **AMERCIA’S NATIONAL INDEPENDENCE DAY PARADE**. Enjoy the entire day downtown to take in all of the patriotic celebrations. This evening a dinner voucher is provided for **UNION STATION**. Return to the hotel tonight after the evening concert on the Mall.

### Day 7 – JULY 5 (Sat.) – Washington, D.C. - Doswell, VA

Depart this morning for Virginia for a full day at **KINGS DOMINION**.
